I. <u>Minutes</u>

The Board approved the Minutes of its February 2, 2022 meeting.

II. Old Business

Upcoming events:

It was confirmed that on March 24, 2022 Shari Wilson will do a presentation on native plants Via Zoom.

A candidate forum for the Ward 3 City Council seat will be held in the Cleveland Park Library on April 7, 2022. Five of seven campaigns contacted have confirmed that they will attend. The event will start at 6:00 and we will advertise that there will be an informal gathering at Nanny O'Brien's after the event.

Discussions about whether and how to hold events for the Mayor and Attorney General candidates are ongoing.

Mike reported that there had been a broad response, 99 individuals, to the Transportation Survey. Next steps are to present the results to the ANC Transportation Committee and get the results posted on the CPCA web site.

III. CPCA name

The Board voted in favor of changing the name of the CPCA to the Cleveland Park Community Association.

Elizabeth has contacted the DC Department of Community and Public Affairs to confirm the paperwork that is necessary in order to effectuate the name change. Because the "Cleveland Park Citizens Association" is referred to by name in the By-Laws, a change most likely requires a vote by the membership. The Board is discussing how to proceed.

IV. Redistricting issue

There was a general discussion of the status of the ANC redistricting issue and the public interest in it. The Board agreed to take steps to distribute Barr's written comments to the membership and to encourage and assist members in expressing their opinions. A committee led by Barr, including Mike, Alice and John will continue to work on it.
